Clinic Rider Packet

Please Read Thoroughly

- ❖ Stabling included for horses in clinic:
 - Rider is responsible for:
 - Shavings
 - Feed and supplements
 - Hay
 - Water Buckets
 - Stall cleaning
 - Proof of negative coggins within 12 months of clinic date
 - Optional
 - Rider may hire our barn manager to feed in morning and evening and have stall cleaned for an extra fee of \$15.00 a day per horse.
 - If the person responsible for the horse chooses not to participate in this option, then he or she is responsible for feeding and cleaning the stall. If the stall is not cleaned by the responsible party then an extra fee of \$10.00 will be charged.
- ❖ Facilities:
 - 20X60 outdoor arena that will be open Thursday May 19th, 2011 by 1pm for horses participating in the clinic.
 - Spacious stalls with dirt floor, will require shavings
 - Water horse in barn
 - One water bucket hanger, if you wish to have two buckets then a nylon bucket hanger will be needed.
 - Metal hay rack and feeders in stalls
 - Stallion safe stalls
 - Wash rack with hot and cold water and cross ties.
 - Mounting block at arena
 - Paddocks available at extra fee of \$5.00 a day.
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- ❖ Rider Dress Code (Please keep in mind that this clinic will be being filmed for DressageClinic.com)
 - Light colored riding pants (no black)
 - Tall Boots

- Belt
- Tucked in polo shirt
- Riding vest is optional
- Helmet (Required at all times while mounted)
- Gloves of conservative colors
- Spurs and dressage whips are optional, but encouraged to have with you at the arena.
 - Horse:
 - Dressage Saddle
 - Dressage Bridle (Snaffle or Double)
 - If you plan to ride in a double bridle, please have a snaffle bridle with you in case the clinician wishes to change from the double to the snaffle.
 - Black or White leg wraps or boots
 - Braiding is optional, but encouraged
 - Conservative colored saddle pad, white or black is encouraged.

 - Final ride times will be available Wednesday before the clinic.
 - Please keep warm up to a minimum before your ride. You may lounge your horse if necessary, and walking around the arena is permitted a few minutes before your ride. Please stay on the outside of the arena or in the round pin arena. Please be mindful of the film crew so that they can really focus on the lesson being given.
